

Michigan Made Advanced Athletics Health & Safety Update 2020

These health and safety policies are mandated across all Michigan Made Advanced Athletics platforms for all athletes, coaches, officials and spectators, and will be strictly monitored.

Decreasing Potential Exposure to Respiratory Droplets

- All coaches and athletes should monitor themselves daily for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, or any other illnesses prior to participating.
- Anyone with a temperature of greater than 100.3 degrees should not participate and stay home.
- Only two spectators allowed per participant/athlete at any practice or competition, or according to any adjusted state and county guidelines.
- Any person displaying symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to participate.
- Vulnerable individuals should not coach, supervise or participate in any camp, competition or practice.
- When participating in any indoor events with Michigan Made Advanced Athletics, face coverings must be worn by all officials, coaches, contest management, volunteer staff spectators and athletes at all times.
- In outdoor competition, leagues, camps or sessions facilitated by Michigan Made Advanced Athletics, all officials, coaches, contest management and volunteer staff are required to wear face coverings at all times. It is recommended but not required, that spectators also wear face coverings for outdoor events. Athletes must wear face coverings at all times when in the common bench areas, huddles or on the sidelines.
- It is required that spectators MUST practice social distancing as described by the CDC and local health departments.
- Only players, designated coaches and officials will be allowed near the sidelines, practice or playing areas.**

Hygienic Considerations

- There will be sanitization stations around the playing, practicing and spectating areas.
- Athletes will have opportunities at arrival and departure for sanitization of their hands and personal belongings.
- Coaches and officials should sanitize frequently.
- All balls, equipment, frequently used items and surfaces will be cleaned as much as possible.
- Please avoid touching your face, spitting of any kind, and sneeze or cough into a tissue or inside of your elbow.
- There will be NO pre-game or post-game handshakes, high fives, etc.
- There should be no shared towels, gear, etc. between athletes. Athletes should wear their own appropriate uniform and they should be washed after every workout.
- All athletes **MUST** bring their own water bottle. Water bottles should be labeled and not shared.

Protocol for Positive Cases

- Contact Health Department or your primary healthcare provider and follow guidance on timetable to safely return to play.
- Report information to Vince Agnew (vinceagnew@michiganmade.net)
- Do not return to activity until permitted to do so.
- Students, coaches, officials, players and others at the event but NOT in close contact should be closely monitored for symptoms. Remaining symptom free, they may continue to participate. Follow health department guidance on whether you should be tested in this occurrence.
- If, during an MM organized league, a team has to quarantine during the season due to a potential exposure, the games missed are a no-play and will not be considered a forfeit or loss in standings. The contest will not be rescheduled.
- If an MM organized league is cancelled for COVID related reasons or changes in local health and safety guidelines, there will be pro-rated refunds made available.

- If a league/tournament that MM travel sports teams are participating in is cancelled for COVID related reasons or changes in local health and safety guidelines, the third-party leagues cancellation/refund policy will be communicated and followed.

Agreement

By participating in the Michigan Made family of sports, I agree to take all reasonable measures to ensure the mental and physical health and safety of all athletes, coaches, families and spectators.

- I understand the symptoms of COVID-19 and affirm that I, as well as all household members, have not been diagnosed or knowingly been exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 14 days.
- I understand that MMAA cannot be held liable for any exposure to the COVID-19 virus caused by misinformation on this form or the health history provided by each client.
- I will notify MMAA if my athlete is exposed to or diagnosed with COVID-19.

Please Note: Your health information is protected. Even if a family/athlete acknowledges and publicly discloses a positive test, MM officials will not participate in the discussion of a positive test identifying a family/athlete at any point.
